Fr. Aaron started the meeting with a prayer.

Meeting was called to order at 6:38 PM.

- May 2 minutes were approved by consensus.
- Financial statements were reviewed and approved. The council was also informed that an additional \$5,000 was taken from the D&L this week to help cover expenses. The D&L saving account balance is now \$17,789.17.

Financial/ Pastoral Business:

- Fr. had a discussion with the council of the overall financial picture and relationship to the mission of the parish.
- The fiscal year reports were reviewed and approved.
- Fr. discussed support of matching tuition with TCS.
- Sheep Shed: There are complications with the sale and who the county has listed as owner of the sheep shed. After some discussion the council decided to move forward without the lawyer so fees do not continue. The council members will make some calls and see if it can be done in a different way.

Buildings and Grounds Business:

- Roof shingling: The roofing project is completed. The total cost of the project was \$110,896.43, which included work on the rectory. The total income for the project was \$83,244.85.
- Front door awning: The council decided to pass on the idea of putting up an awning. They wondered if the funeral homes may have something that they could use if needed.

The meeting closed with a prayer at 7:25 p.m.
