The regular Finance Council meeting was called to order on February 11, 2020 at 6:35 PM in Fort Atkinson. Fr. Radloff began the meeting with a prayer. The members reviewed the minutes from the October meeting, which were accepted by consensus. Next, the members reviewed the financial statements including the profit/loss sheet, balance sheet and annual financial report. The roof repairs have been paid in full and financially we are doing fine.

Financial / Pastoral Business: We received the Tabernacle back and it looks great. Father mentioned he would like to build a base and have it secured to the base.

We will need to wait until spring to take a closer look at it and either patch it or resurface the whole parking lot.
