Father Aaron opened the meeting with a prayer.

Meeting was called to order at 6:36 PM.

Minutes from May 9th meeting were approved. Financials reports were reviewed and accepted.

Financial and Pastoral Business:

- Fiscal year reports were reviewed and annual meeting minutes were signed.
- Fr. discussed support of matching tuition with TCS. The tuition from the church will be \$7,200 this year; this is \$100 more than the previous year.

Building and Grounds Business:

- Self inspection: Ken will work with other council members to get the report completed in the next week.
- Furnace bids: Ken received two estimates on the furnace. After some discussion it was decided to go with Fredericksburg Plumbing & Heating whose bid was \$10,825.00 and Fencil Oil for the Lp tank and fuel. The Council will put a note in the bulletin that they wish to receive \$13,000 in donation to help cover the expenses for the project.
- Steve said there are bats in the church. Ken and Steve will work resolving this issue.
- There is soot throughout the church; the council will look into getting this cleaned. While they are at it some ceiling fans will be replaced while scaffolding is up.
- Steve brought up a list of projects that needs to be addressed in the future. These include the ac not working properly, paint bubbling in the choir area, a wet area in the basement most likely caused by the drops in the gutter that need to be raised.
